Wynantskill, NY – Vanderheyden will host an open house for their new program that serves young adults with developmental disabilities seeking a personalized, site based day habilitation experience. To become part of Day Hab, an individual must be eligible by the Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD). Programming is designed to ensure that small groups and individual experiences take place to foster skill development and community involvement.
